Eligibility and application deadline extended!**

If you are an Orange resident and are low to moderate income (even if due to recent COVID-19 related financial challenges) apply NOW for Recipe for Wellness, a program co-created by Seeds of Solidarity and Quabbin Harvest.

Twenty families will receive a box of fresh vegetables and fruit every other week (16 total boxes of food), starting end of April and into the Fall. Plus a recipe and activity guide!

Please fill this out and return to: Quabbin Harvest, 12 N. Main St Orange, no later than April 10 but the sooner the better as we will accept on a rolling basis! We will let you know by April 12 if you are accepted for participation. **Or**, contact Deb Habib, Seeds of Solidarity deb@seedsofsolidarity.org to be sent an application and return envelope or to complete an application by phone. In addition to receiving fresh vegetables, there will be gardening and cooking workshops this summer and fall.

This is not the HIP (Healthy Incentive Program).
